

Support our SMESA member, Mary Soo Help Give Oasis Second Chance Animal Shelter a Second Chance!



At 78 years old, Mary Soo is redefining what retirement looks like. Instead of relaxing and enjoying a leisurely life, she dedicates her days to running Oasis Second Chance Animal Shelter (OSCAS), a sanctuary for over 70 rescued dogs. Nestled in Sungei Tengah, this two-storey shelter is more than just a temporary home—it's a place where abandoned and injured dogs find love, care, and a second chance at life.

Mary's passion for animal welfare started when she was a student volunteering with the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA). Even after a successful career in banking, she continued her mission, co-founding OSCAS in 2006 after rescuing stray dogs from a forested area in Changi. For nearly 20 years, she has poured her heart, time, and even her personal savings into keeping OSCAS running. She has downsized her own home to fund the shelter, ensuring that every dog receives the love and medical attention they need.

At OSCAS, no dog is turned away. Injured, abandoned, elderly—every furry friend who arrives is given the best possible care. Over 40% of the shelter's residents are senior dogs, many of whom struggle to find forever homes despite being capable of living well into their twenties with proper care. Mary runs OSCAS like a home, ensuring each dog is treated with dignity, love, and respect.

How You Can Help:


Ponate Every dollar goes a long way in providing food, medical care, and shelter for these dogs. Your generosity ensures they continue to receive the care they deserve.
