# St. Margaret's 180<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Thanksgiving Service By Juliana Tengara

Founder's Day brings together members of the St Margaret's Family for a time of remembrance, fellowship and celebration. And indeed what a joyous (and tearjerking) this year's anniversary was, as a crowd of almost 600 comprising staff and students of SMPS and SMSS – both past and present – congregated in-person for the first time since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 180th Anniversary took place in the beautiful St. Andrew's Cathedral New Santuary – a fitting venue to celebrate the milestone.

The Thanksgiving Service began with a prayer by Reverend Tang Wai Lung, Priest of St. John's Chapel, and an opening address by Professor Lawrence Boo, Chairman of the School Management Committee. Both honoured God for His abundant blessings and favour upon St. Margaret's for the past 180 years, enabling the schools to grow from strength to strength, furthering the work of Mrs Maria Dyer to light the paths of many young ladies and the community beyond. In addition, Professor Boo took the opportunity to honour the presence of The Right Reverend Dr. Titus Chung, Reverend Canon Dr. Lewis Lew, members of the school chaplain, former principals of SMPS and SMSS as well as alumni. He thanked them for their stewardship, faithful support and prayers.

Celebrations continued with the school song, songs of praise and worship, led by the choirs of both SMPS and SMSS as well as staff and students in their respective performances. The audience was also treated to a video montage documenting commemorative activities that took place over the year.




We thank too the school Principals and staff, the SMESA's Presidents, past and present and Committee.

# St. Margaret's School Alumna Award

The St. Margaret's School Alumna Award (the Alumna Award) was set up in 2018 by the School Management Committee (SMC) specially to recognise the outstanding service and dedication to the School by members of the St. Margaret's Ex-Students' Association (SMESA).

The Alumna Award is to be distinguished from the St. Margaret's School Service Award as the latter applies to all the School partners, namely, PSG, SMESA and others whereas the Alumna Award concerns only the members of SMESA.

The Alumna Award is conferred every year where there are deserving candidates but the presenting of the Award is carried out at the significant anniversary celebration of the School such as the 180th Anniversary of the School and every 5 years thereafter. A plague is presented to the recipient.

There are 2 categories of the Alumna Award, namely:

- Distinguished Award
- · Meritorious Award

Candidates have to meet the requisite criteria in order to be conferred the respective category of the Alumna Award.

Up to the present day, the following candidates were conferred the Alumna Award:-

- Two candidates were conferred the Distinguished Award on 16 November 2018, namely, Dr. Lee Hoon Hwee and Ms Lee Soo Kwan; and
- · One candidate, namely, Ms Chew Siew Kheng, was conferred the Distinguished Award on 20 September 2022.
